Affiliation

SASA(Scottish Amateur Swimming Association) is the membership body of Scottish Swimming and comprises of four districts – North, Midlands, East and West and has 160 affiliated clubs.

PCSC is in SASA Midlands District.

SASA Midland District and its clubs are affiliated to Scottish Swimming, the National Governing Body for Swimming in Scotland.

By joining an affiliated swimming club, our members can be assured that the club is safe, inclusive, compliant, competitive, sustainable and connected. It means that a club is operating in a safe and compliant way and has achieved the minimum standard of safe and effective practice. In doing so, members of an affiliated club are permitted to train and compete safely and with insurance.

Swimmers can join PCSC as 1st claim or 2nd claim and volunteers are given non-swimming membership.

Code of Conduct

All athletes and volunteers representing PCSC are expected to abide by the relevant code of conduct and behave in accordance with all PCSC guidelines, policies & procedures.

Club Kit

Athletes:

All athletes affiliated to PCSC are required to wear club kit WHEN REPRESENTING PCSC IN COMPETITION.

This includes the red club cap in the water and PCSC top while receiving medals or making podium appearances.

Volunteers:

All coaches, team staff and officials will be provided with club tops that should be worm when representing PCSC as a volunteer.
